

Single Room (Second Round)

1. Eligibility: International Students who are planning to be newly enrolled at Gifu University for more than 6 months from April 2017 and who satisfy any of the following conditions:
 - ① Students who passed the Second Round Entrance Examination for Doctoral–Master’s Program
 - ② Students who passed the Entrance Examination for Privately–Financed International Students
 - ③ Non–degree seeking students 【International students who obtain an entrance admission after the First Round of application period is closed (~ Feb 9, 2017)】
2. Numbers of Rooms available... about 5 rooms
3. Period of Residency... from April 3, 2017 to March 26, 2018 (non–extendable) or from April 3, 2017 to September 25, 2017
4. Period of Application
From February 10 (Fri), 2017 through March 8 (Wed), 2017 (12:00 pm) *must arrive*
5. Delivery of Notice of Acceptance... March 10 (Fri), 2017

We will inform the result of acceptance at the International House to the staff of your faculty / graduate school.

6. Documents to Submit
 - (1) Application Form (for Second Round)

 - (2) Residence Card or a copy of your Passport with your photo
 - (3) A copy of Authorization of Resident Eligibility or Application Receipt if you are a new self–supporting international student.
 - (4) A copy of Permission of Acceptance or Certificate of Acceptance of Gifu University
7. Notice for Application
Eligibility
 - (1) Those who have a visa status “College Student” at the time of moving in (“Short–term Resident” visa cannot apply)
 - (2) Those who receive more than 145,000 yen per month as his/her staying expense (in the form of either “salary” or “scholarship money”) from various organizations, are not allowed to apply for the International House.
*The amount of “145,000 yen per month” is equivalent to a monthly salary of a Japanese government–funded graduate–level international student.
 - (3) International students with a record of stay of more than 12 months in the International House are not allowed to apply for the International House (Period of residence as Japanese Language & Culture Studies students and Exchange students shall not be included in resident history.)
 - (4) International students who are planning to take leaves of absence from the University are not allowed to apply for the International House.
Other Requirements
 - (5) Those who own a car are required to show your “Driver’s License” and “Optional Insurance (Auto Insurance Policy).” Students who park at the International House need Japanese Driver’s license.
 - (6) Permission of residence could be invalidated if an approved student did not move into the International House within 10 days from the designated starting day of residence. If you cannot move into International House within 10 days, please submit a written statement of reasons in advance.
 - (7) A resident who is ordered to leave the International House or who is given a warning from the

Director of the International House, are not allowed to apply for the International House.

- (8) If an application includes false information, the permission of residence of the applicant in question is immediately invalidated, and his/her application to the International House will never be accepted in the future.

Please submit the documents to each faculty/graduate school staff within the period.

10. Other precautions

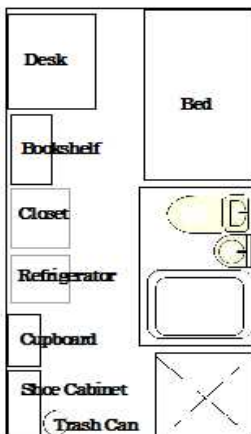
- (1) Please read the rules of International House carefully.

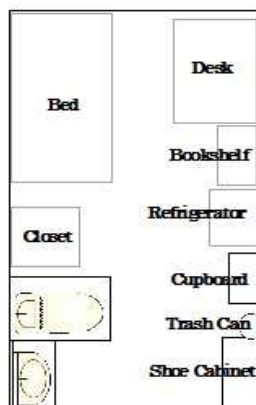

★ The rules of International House

- Smoking in the International House is strictly prohibited.
- Overnight visitors are strictly prohibited. Even your friends and families are not allowed to stay with you.
- Non-residents are prohibited to enter the resident's room and kitchen.
- Visiting hours are from 9AM through 10PM every day including weekends. Visitation is permitted only in the lobby of Building A. Visitors are not allowed to enter any areas other than the lobby of Building A.
- Non-residents are prohibited to enter and use the kitchen room and eat there with residents.
- Tutors: Gifu University students are assigned to the House. Please follow their instructions.
