

Scholarship

1. Scholarship Payment

Japanese government scholarship students need to open the *Japan Post Bank (Yucho Bank)* savings account at the post office soon after arrival in Japan in order to accept the monthly grant. When you open a bank account, you will need to present your national health insurance card. So you must be done your national health insurance procedures at the municipal office before you opening your bank account.

The first day of the each month, Japanese government scholarship students must sign (or *inkan*) the student identification report at the faculty/graduate school office in order to ensure that he/she remains enrolled at Gifu University. After confirmed your attendance, monthly grant will be transferred to individual *Yucho Bank* accounts.

(Note)

Japanese government scholarship students who make a temporary return to their home countries from the beginning through the end of the month, monthly grant won't be paid for that month. Also grant money won't be paid to the student who is taking a registered absence from school either.
