## 1. Purpose

This Ski School is conducted for the purpose of strengthening mutual exchanges among international students, and having a contact with winter nature and sports culture through ski skills acquisition and camp life as one of the educational activities of international students.

- ① International students who can participate in Ski School throughout the entire period
- ② A member of National Health Insurance

## 6. Number of Participants

30 people (Ski School will be canceled if less than 20 people.)  
Applications will be accepted on a first-come, first-served basis.

## 7. Participation Fee

10,000 yen (Travel and lodging expenses, and rental ski set fee)  
Lunch is not included.  
Those who need a rental skiwear and ski related accessories require additional fee.
