Steps to be taken against COVID-19 (December 29, 2021 – January 3, 2022)

(Points of Attention in Daily Life)

*Please follow the instructions below even if you are fully vaccinated.

- Please take body temperature in the morning before leaving home to attend classes. If you have high fevers or cold-like symptoms, etc. please contact the Health Administration Center and student affairs office of your faculty/school/center, etc. and stay at home.
- Wear a mask when going out and minimize conversations while using public transportation (trains, busses, etc.)
- Please use hand sanitizer and wash hands carefully at bathroom, and particularly before meals.
- Keep record of your body temperatures, physical conditions and daily activities.
- Please keep distance from others, wear a mask and minimize conversations during meals. Please refrain from dining out in a large group and avoid the "Three Cs."
- Please exercise self-restraint for non-essential outings to any afflicted regions and follow the Japanese government instructions (access "MOFA's Travel Advice and Warning on Infectious Diseases") if you are planning to travel abroad.
- Shortness of breath (difficulty of breathing), strong fatigue, or high fevers, etc.
- Have underlying conditions, high fevers, coughing and other mild cold-like symptoms.
- Mild cold-like symptoms such as high fevers, coughing, etc. continue.
