RE: University's responses to those with body temperature of 37.5°C and above

Anyone who develops a fever of 37.5°C and above for more than four days, is suspected of being infected with COVID-19. Gifu University dormitories take the form of a "share house" with lots of common spaces, and we need to separate the infected individuals from the rest without waiting for these four days.

We appreciate your cooperation and understanding concerning the following Gifu University responses to prevent the spread of COVID-19 infections:

In case a dormitory resident develops a fever of 37.5°C and above, we ask him/her to return home to rest, but if situations do not allow him/her to return home, we deal with individuals depending on the situations (we may ask guardians to take the residents home by car).
