RE: Reminder of COVID-19 Prevention Measures

It was learned that one Gifu University student was infected with COVID-19. In response to this confirmation, Gifu University is posting every update of the infection status on campus in our university website. Against the backdrop of ever increasing daily tally of COVID-19 patients in Japan and the world, we would like to remind the university students of the importance of taking thorough infection prevention measures.

The public health center in charge has already confirmed that no one on campus came close contact with the student. Therefore, there is no change in schedules for classes, examinations, etc. at this point. However, please do not hesitate to contact teaching staff, supervisors, student affairs section of your faculties, schools, centers, etc. if you are worried about your class attendance or taking examinations, and contact the Health Administration Center if you are concerned about your mental or physical conditions anytime.

We ask for your kind understanding and cooperation for our university policy of respecting the student's and his/her family's human rights and protecting their privacy (among others, please do not speculate about the student's identity or post any defamatory massages about the student on social networking sites, etc.)

<Commuting to and from Campus>

- 1. Please take your temperature when you get up in the morning, and if you have a fever or cold-like symptoms, contact the Health Administration Center and student affairs section of your faculty/school/center, etc. and stay home.
- 2. Please wear a face mask on your way to and from campus.
- 3. Please minimize your conversations while on public transportation (trains or busses) and avoid 3Cs (closed spaces, crowded places and close-contact settings.)
- 4. If you take a bus from the Gifu Station, please avoid taking crowded busses.

5. (newly added) Please keep a record of your daily events and activities as you may ask to submit such record to public health centers, etc. should you be suspected of having a close contact with infected individuals.

<On Campus>

- 1. Please wear a mask while on campus.
- 2. Please minimize time spent on campus.
- 3. Please disinfect your hands with hand sanitizer or wash your hands with soap and water in the bathrooms (disinfecting your hands is particularly necessary before meals).
- 4. Please try to take a seat away from others, and minimize your conversations while eating.
- 5. If teaching staff gives you instructions as to where to take a seat, or ventilate the room, please follow their instructions.
- 6. (newly added) Please keep a record of your daily events and activities as you may ask to submit such record to public health centers, etc. should you be suspected of having a close contact with infected individuals.

<Other>

1. (newly added) Please refrain from attending get-together, social gatherings, etc. held in places where no infection measures are in place.
