Second Semester 2020 Tuition Waiver for Students in Financial Difficulties due to COVID-19

Gifu University waived tuitions of 2020 First Semester for students who are facing great financial difficulties due to the spread of COVID-19. If you want to apply for a tuition waiver for Second Semester 2020, please confirm whether you can meet the following and access AIMS-Gifu for application. Students are asked to submit a) or b) to the Student Support Division before the deadline. If you have any questions, please feel free to contact the Division.

Tuition Waiver Criteria

If you fall into the following a) or b), you are eligible to apply for a tuition waiver.

a) I have applied for public support fund because my family income was significantly reduced due to the spread of COVID-19. I can submit a copy of my recipient certificate (even if an applicant is still in the process of application, he/she still needs to submit an official document proving his/her status.)

b) My annual income is less than half the income of last year due to COVID-19 (method of calculation: the last three month incomes multiplied by 4)

*An applicant also needs to meet criteria of Gifu University Tuition Waiver System (An applicant is asked to submit a number of official documents including a certificate of income and withholding tax.)
