【概要】

岐阜大学教育学部生涯教育課程 3 年生 金武李佳（かねたけ りか）さんが、3 月 26 日～29 日に New York で開催される「New York Global Young Leaders Summit International Model United Nations 2013」（通称「模擬国連」）に参加します。

模擬国連では、参加学生がある国の大使の役割を演じ、担当国の政策や歴史、外交関係などに照らし合わせて、特定の議題について実際の国連における会議と同様に議論、交渉し、国際問題への理解や交渉術の深化を図ります。

今回、金武李佳さんは、九州地区の大学の学生と 3 人でモロッコを担当することになり、現在、在京のモロッコ大使館を訪問し、モロッコの（特に）経済事情などについて情報収集を行い、参加準備を進めています。

また、教育学部英語教育講座の巽（たつみ）准教授、David Barker（ディビッドバーカー）准教授が指導にあたっています。

なお、金武李佳さんは、今年 8 月より、岐阜大学交換留学生として、米国の学術協定大学へ 10 ヶ月ほど（2 セメスター）留学する予定です。

During the Summit, students will learn the importance of balancing national interests with the needs of the international community, while also learning about the power and limitations of international negotiations.

Leadership, critical analysis, public speaking, persuasion, negotiation are the main skills that students will acquire through their participation to the New York Global Young Leaders Summit Int'l Model UN, where delegates will also have the chance to build strong new friendships that span across the globe.

The NY-GYLS Int'l MUN makes students closer to the current international issues, making them aware of the importance of fast, efficient and strategic solutions, and contributes to prepare the next generation of leaders.

The NY- GYLS Int'l MUN is organized by the International Committee for United Nations Culture and Education Promotion (ICCE), an international consortium of MUN Experts and



Academics in International Relations, Foreign Policy and Strategic Studies in collaboration with United Nations and with the support of national, international and governmental institutions.

For this year the NY-GYLS Int'l MUN 2013 is scheduled to take place in New York, on 26-29 March 2013.
