### International Student Employment in Local Businesses: Perspectives from international students, businesses and universities

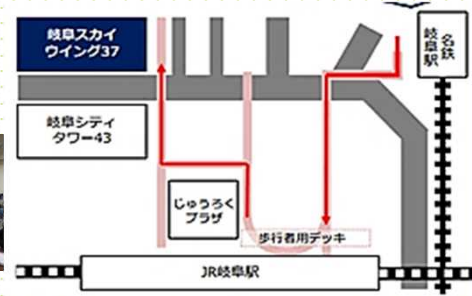
