The term "Soroptimist" derived from the Latin. "Soro" means "sisters" and "optima" means "optimal" in English. Wen combined, the word signifies "the best for women." Soroptimist International was established in 1921 in Oakland, the United States as the biggest women volunteer organization in the world. Their activities include women empowerment projects, environment conservation, promotion of education, international friendship and understanding as well as sound growth of the youths for better society in the future.
